

**NOTICE OF MANDATORY HEARING AND SCHEDULING CONFERENCE  
REGARDING UNRESOLVED WATER RIGHT**

**PLEASE TAKE NOTICE** that the Court has set a Hearing and Scheduling Conference to be held at 1:00 p.m., Thursday, August 9, 2018 (Trailing Docket), at the Sixth Judicial District Court, 300 Shakespeare, Lordsburg, NM 88045. The purpose of the Hearing and Scheduling Conference is to assess the status of disputed Subfiles AUB-011-0001A, AUB-011-0001B, AUB-011-0001C, AUB-011-0001D, AUB-011-0004B, AUB-012-0004, AUB-012-0014 and AUB-013-0003A associated with claimant J&C VICTOR 2006 TRUST, and to determine what actions need to be taken in light of the rejection of State's proposed judgment.

**Attendance at the Hearing and Scheduling Conference is mandatory.** The Court may enter sanctions against any party who fails to attend. If the State and subfile claimant resolve all issues relating to claimant's water rights prior to the Status Conference and the State so informs the Court, the claimant need not attend the Status Conference.
